



Arctic Sun Dogwood

Cornus sanguinea 'Cato'



With its yellow stems and red tips, this dwarf deciduous shrub will add a splash of color to the winter blah. The leaves are green in the spring and summer and turn bright yellow in the fall.

Mature Size: 3-4' Tall by 3-4' Wide

Light Requirements: Light Shade

Soil Requirements: Quite Adaptable



Maintenance: Requires pruning every 2-3 years. The best pruning practice for this type of shrub is to remove about 25% of the oldest canes at the base.
